Scriptural Readings

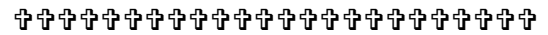
First Reading: Isaiah 55.10-11

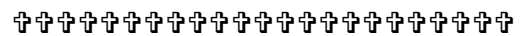
The office will be closed Tuesday and Wednesday.
