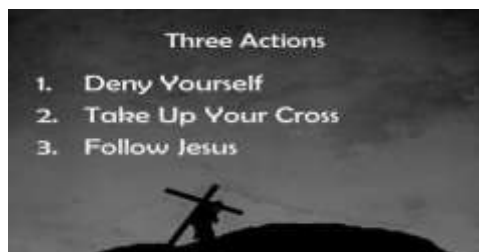
Scriptural Readings
