It was launched by Archbishop Prendergast and Rabbi Reuven Bulka, Emeritus Rabbi of congregation Machzeikai Hadas. This amazing Exhibition, prepared by volunteers and funded by private donations, presents a powerful sample of Jewish contribution to our country.

All are encouraged to take the time to view this exhibition during regular business hours (8:30 am to 4:30 pm) Monday to Friday.

Call for Conscience Campaign

The Archdiocese of Ottawa, in agreement with the Association of Ontario Bishops, is helping in the initiative of the Call for Conscience Campaign organized by the Coalition for HealthCare and Conscience. This initiative is seeking the participation of Catholic parishes in raising awareness of euthanasia/assisted suicide and the discriminatory position in which doctors, caregivers, and healthcare providers find themselves.

The Campaign is underway. Archbishop Prendergast, and the Ontario Bishops are asking for an email address from every Catholic family with a goal of 100,000 email addresses collected by the end of February 2018. This information will be used to communicate periodically on issues of particular importance for the Catholic community. Your information will only be provided with the Archbishop's permission.

The first campaign of 2018 is the Call for Conscience, inviting our elected Members of Provincial Parliament (MPPs) and those seeking office this June to increase funding/access to palliative care, to protect health care workers wishing to abstain from any involvement in euthanasia/assisted suicide and to protect faith-based facilities from participation in euthanasia/assisted suicide.
